




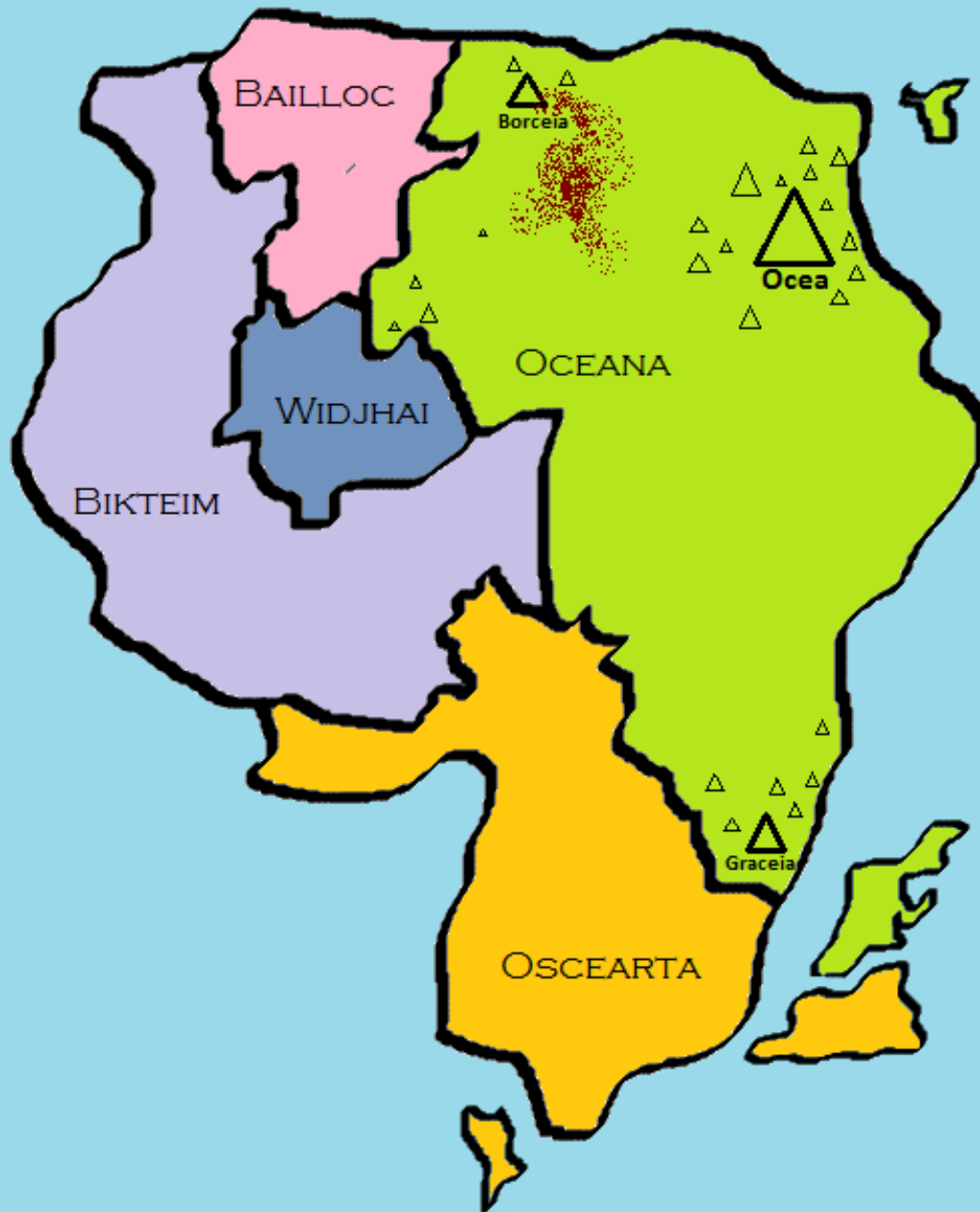

# Rules

# Public statement

- Prepare a brief oral statement that one of your team members can give to the public media.

- Presentation:

  - UN
- Journalists may ask each presenter up to 3 questions

# Negotiation and information sharing
